## **RULES GOVERNING USE OF THE POOL – SUMMER 2026**

These rules help maintain a safe, clean, and enjoyable environment at the Cedarbrook pool. Members are responsible for the conduct and supervision of their children and guests and must follow all pool rules and lifeguard instructions.

Lifeguards have full authority to enforce these rules. Failure to comply may result in removal from the pool area and/or suspension of pool privileges.

### **OPENING DATE**

May 23, 2026

### **OPERATING HOURS**

Monday through Sunday  
10:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Closing Date: September 27, 2026. For updates or weather-related closures, call the pool phone at (336) 835-5038.

The pool is for general member use during operating hours and may not be reserved for private events before 7:00 p.m. The pool may close due to weather, safety, maintenance, or operational needs at the discretion of Club management.

### **AGE & SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS**

Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult or approved babysitter.

Children ages 12–17 may remain without an adult only if a lifeguard is on duty and the child can swim one full length of the pool unassisted, as determined by the lifeguard.

The lifeguard on duty may require a swim test at any time and has final authority on swimming ability.

When a “No Lifeguard on Duty” sign is posted:

- Swim at your own risk.
- No one under 18 is permitted in the pool area unless accompanied and directly supervised by a parent or legal guardian.
- Adults are strongly advised not to swim alone.

## **BABYSITTERS**

Babysitters are permitted under these guidelines:

- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- May be non-members when supervising a member's child.
- No guest fee while supervising children.
- May not bring additional guests.
- If under 18, may use the pool only when a lifeguard is on duty.
- Staff/lifeguards may approve or deny access based on safety and supervision needs.

## **GUESTS**

Guests are welcome when accompanied by a sponsoring member.

- Guest fee: \ \$8 per guest, per day.
- Guest wristbands are required and must be worn at the pool.
- 10-pack wristbands: \ \$50 (Pro Shop).

Members must remain with their guests and are responsible for their conduct.

Non-member grandchildren (through age 17) may use the pool at no charge when accompanied by the member grandparent.

During peak periods, the Club may limit guests per membership.

## **REGISTRATION**

All members and guests must sign in upon arrival.

Guest fees are paid in the Pro Shop. Members need a blue member key tag for entry; pick up tags at the start of the season or on your first visit (Pro Shop).

## **SWIMMING LESSONS**

Swimming lessons may be arranged directly with lifeguards and are conducted outside normal operating hours.

Lesson fees are paid directly to the instructor; rates are posted at the pool.

## **POOL USE & SAFETY**

Use of the pool is at your own risk. Parents, guardians, and babysitters are responsible for children at all times.

The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property.

Personal lounge chairs, equipment, and toys may not be stored on Club property.

Saving chairs is not permitted. Chairs may not be reserved for more than 30 minutes without active use; unattended items may be removed by staff.

Safety rules (apply at all times):

- No pets in the pool area.
- No glass or other breakable containers.
- No smoking inside the fenced pool area or within 10 feet of gates/entrances.
- Floats, inner tubes, fins, and other accessories require lifeguard approval.
- No running, roughhousing, horseplay, or rocking the pool.
- Children under 5 may use only the kiddie pool.
- Pool phone use requires lifeguard permission (except emergencies).
- Keep clear of ladders, steps, ropes, and railings except when entering/exiting.
- Report all injuries immediately to a lifeguard or Cedarbrook staff member.
- Diving board use must follow lifeguard instructions; ensure the area is clear before diving.

If glass is broken in or around the pool area, the pool will close immediately. The responsible party will be financially responsible for required cleaning, vacuuming, inspection, and reopening procedures.

## **FOOD & BEVERAGE**

Outside food and beverages are permitted; glass containers are strictly prohibited.

Please dispose of all trash in designated receptacles before leaving.

## **PRIVATE PARTY RENTALS**

Members may reserve the pool for private parties after operating hours.

- Parties: 7:00 p.m.–9:00 p.m.
- Facility fee: \ \$50.
- Lifeguards: \ \$20/hour, per lifeguard.
- Parties with more than 25 guests require two lifeguards.

All private parties must use Cedarbrook-approved lifeguards scheduled through the Club. Outside lifeguards are not permitted without advanced management approval.

The sponsoring member is responsible for guest conduct and for the condition of the facility during the event.

Limited weekday daytime gatherings may be approved on a case-by-case basis if they do not restrict member access or interfere with operations.

Unless approved in advance, gatherings are limited to 15 guests.

## **BATH HOUSE**

Please help keep dressing rooms, restrooms, and pool facilities clean and in good working condition. Trash receptacles are provided; members and guests must dispose of trash during and after each visit.

## **PARKING**

Park in designated spaces in the clubhouse lot or gravel overflow area. Parking along Country Club Road or on grass areas of Cedarbrook property is prohibited.
